Daily Health Screening Questions

Parents should be instructed to keep their child at home if they are ill and answer yes to any of the daily health screening questions. Any student or staff member with a fever of 100.4 degrees or greater or symptom of possible COVID-19 virus infection should not be present in school.

Parent / Staff Screening Questions:

For students, the parents/guardians should be asked to screen their children for symptoms or risk factors daily before allowing the child to travel to school.

1. Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms?

Nausea, Vomiting, or Diarrhea

fever (100.4F or higher) and/or chills

nasal congestion or new runny nose (not related to seasonal allergies)

muscle/body aches/fatigue

Cough and/or Shortness of breath

headache/sore throat

new loss of taste or smell

If you or someone in your household are positive or awaiting results for Covid 19, please call your school nurse, who will review NH DHHS K-12 schools guidance states 02/07/22 for eligibility to attend school. A copy of a lab test or a picture of a home test will be required.

If the child is dismissed from school, a responsible adult will be required to pick up within 30 minutes- please have a dismissal plan prepared.
