8651- SPECIAL USE OF SCHOOL BUSES (M)

The Willingboro Township School District shall furnish, at district expense, bus transportation for school-sponsored activities, unless hereinafter excepted, when the destination is within New Jersey or the metropolitan areas of New York City, Philadelphia, or Wilmington. School-sponsored activities are those directly related to the curricula and interscholastic athletic program. The total transportation cost of trips meeting the above specifications will be paid by the Board of Education.

Pupil Spectator Bus Trips

School buses may be used to transport pupil spectators and chaperones to various interschool functions. The district shall be reimbursed the actual costs for such trips as determined by the Director of Transportation.

Special Bus Trips

School buses may be used to transport pupils and faculty sponsors on class activity trips and other non-athletic extra-curricular activity trips. The district shall be reimbursed the actual costs for such trips as determined by the Director of Transportation.

Other Special Uses

At various times other school districts, due to emergency or unusual circumstances, request the use of buses owned by the school district. Such usage shall be permitted provided the other district reimburses the Willingboro Township School District for the actual costs involved, is adequately insured and agrees to indemnify the Board for any personal or property damage occurring as a result of its usage. School buses shall not be used by or on behalf of private, commercial, or religious organizations.
