

Screening is a quick, no-cost, check to identify possible health or developmental concerns in infants and young children who may need a health assessment, mental health assessment or educational evaluation. Screening in early childhood supports children's learning and promotes health and development. Screening must take place between age 3 and kindergarten, or within the first 30 days of kindergarten or first grade. Screening between the ages of 3 and 4 provides the best opportunity for any health or developmental concerns to be found early.


