Drop off Procedures

Please review the following drop off procedures for your child at school. We need your help to keep your children and our school safe. Every child is important to us! Please abide by the following drop off procedures;

- The lane closest to the school is the unloading lane. **Please pull up to the farthest point** of the curve. Students should exit from the passenger side of the vehicle **ONLY**.
- Please do not leave your car unattended in the unloading lane.
- The middle lane is for cars that are passing through. **Do not** unload students from this lane.
- The lane closest to the visitor's parking is to remain clear for those pulling in and pulling out of parking spots.
- If you are dropping off and walking your child to the school for a meeting or signing into the Preschool, please park in the visitor's parking spots. If all places are filled, park on the street.

Please be careful, cooperative and patient! Watch out for kids and cars.
