The Massachusetts Bullying Prevention Act

Requires Districts to develop a Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan.

Model plan developed by DESE includes 10 sections: Leadership, Training and Professional Development, Access to Resources and Services, Academic and Non-Academic Activities, Policies and Procedures for reporting and responding to bullying and retaliation, Collaboration with families, Prohibition against bullying and retaliation, Problem resolution system, Definitions, and Collaboration to other laws.

Bullying, and the Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan (proposed Plan September 2022)

Revising the GDRSD Bullying Plan

- Spring 2022 shared initial draft of a Bullying Plan based on the MA Bullying Prevention Act using the DESE model plan for format and content
- Received meaningful feedback with requests for an expanded plan including more specificity
- Reviewed plans from other districts
- Incorporated feedback to develop a revised plan as well as supplemental documents (e.g., forms, FAQs, relevant procedures)

- Share out new Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan: post on website, share with families and staff in multiple ways
- Share other related resources: post on website, share with families and staff in multiple ways

What should I do? What can I do to help? What happens after?

- Share and begin using new allegation reporting <u>form</u> and procedures
- Review allegation reports for monitoring, accountability, and data reporting
- Review district reporting data with YRBS, VOCAL and potentially other sources of data

- Establish Trainer Team for Professional Development (Certified as MARC Trainers)
- Expand annual professional development offerings to educators on bullying prevention and intervention
- Provide workshops for families on bullying prevention and intervention
- Expand annual professional development offerings to administrators on bullying prevention and intervention, and conducting investigations

- Provide bullying prevention and intervention instruction to students
 - PK to 8: Pilot "Second Step (Tier 1 curriculum, DESE approved)
 - 9-12: District developed
