3. Watch closely for changes. If symptoms worsen, give epinephrine.		
1. INJECT EPINEPHRINE IMMEDIATELY.		
2. Call 911. Tell emergency dispatcher the person is having anaphylaxis and may need epinephrine when emergency MEDICATIONS/DOSES		
responders arrive. Epinephrine Brand or Generic:		
• Consider giving additional medications following epinephrine:		
» Antihistamine » Inhaler (bronchodilator) if wheezing Epinephrine Dose: 0.15 mg IM 0.3 mg IM		3 mg IM
» Inhaler (bronchodilator) if wheezing Lay the person flat, raise legs and keep warm. If breathing is Antihistamine Brand or Generic:		
difficult or they are vomiting, let them sit up or lie on their side.		
If symptoms do not improve, or symptoms return, more doses of epinephrine can be given about 5 minutes or more after the last dose.

Transport patient to ER, even if symptoms resolve. Patient should remain in ER for at least 4 hours because symptoms may return.
