General Education Core Requirements (minimum of 12 credits):

- Written Communication (3 - 6 credits):
  - ENGL 1010 or ENGL 2010
- Quantitative Literacy (3-4 credits):
  - MATH 1030, MATH/STAT 1040, or MATH 1050
- American Institutions (3-6 credits):
  - ECON 1740, HIST 1700, HIST 2700/2710, or POLS 1100

- Includes the award of an institutional credential for up to 900 hours or 30 credit hours

- Arts (3 credits)
- Humanities (3 credits)
- Life Sciences (3 credits)
- Physical Sciences (3 credits)
- Social and Behavioral Sciences (3 credits)
