#### Title I School Parents Right-to-Know – Highly Qualified Teacher (HQT)

This is the term *used* for a teacher who proves that he or she knows the subjects he or she is teaching, has a college degree, and is state-certified. As a parent of a student enrolled at a school receiving Title I funding, Federal law allows parents to request information regarding the professional qualifications for your child's teacher or instructional aide. If information is needed, contact your building principal. (Source: Ohio Dept. of Education; Title I, Part A, Section 1111(h)).

Bekeal is the latest trending social media app. The concept is that people see others in their authentic day to day, lives, sharing condid photos without editing or applying filters tach day at a random time, users are simultaneously notified to take a picture of what they re doing at that exact moment. The two minute window to submit an image means there is no time to select a particularly glamorous or exciting activity. Bekeal shares two pictures: a selfie and an image of the immediate surroundings.

Users can only view and react to their friends, photos once they upload their own.

#### WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

#### CONTINUOUS NOTIFICATIONS

Like any social media app.
Befeal's developers with users
to be an it requisitly and screlling for
long periods. Befeal only sends one
notification to past a picture each day,
but there are other alerts for events
such as mentions, comments, friend
requests and reactions to your photo.
This can cause young users to feel
pressure to open the app and respond,
districting them from other autwittes.

#### CONNECTING WITH STRANGERS

When someone signs up to Belleol, it bighlights anyone in their phone's contacts list who already has the appose users can connect with friends, or invite others from their contacts. The Discovery' leed, meanwhile, shows posts from strongers and gives users the option to each them as friends, too. This means your child could potentially connect with - and communicate with - a stranger.

#### **PUBLIC SHARING**

As well as sharing posts with triends in the moment, the app also allows posts to be shared publicly and public content to be viewed. Before a user can see this public content, they must post their own photo first. Unfortunately, there currently seems to be a lock of moderation on the content that's being uploaded, so a young user could be exposed to posts which aren't suitable for their age.

#### EASY LOCATION

befred's defoult setting is to share the exact location of where a past was sent from, diven that images are usually shared within the two-minute window, anyone your child is friends with on the app will knew exactly where they are (or of least, where they serve two minutes earlier). As we've noted, this could include strongers who are intending to use this geographical information for militians or process.

#### VISIBLE PERSONAL DATA

As with any other farm of social media, it's important that your child doesn't share too much personal information on their profile. Belleval or a photo, full name, approximate location and a short bio. It's safest to make sure that your child's profile doesn't display anything which could identify where they go to school or wantly where they go to

#### REPUTATIONAL DAMAGE

What your child says and does online - their digital footprint - shapes the way that other people ses them. It's essential that young people understand that when they post something online, they are giving the app in question the right to do wholever they wish with that image or content, including sharing it elsewhere. ## Advice for Parents & Carers

#### LIMIT NOTIFICATIONS

Reflect offers the option to turn off individual types of notification.

is tempted to open the app by incoming comments, uploads, friend

#### STOP AND THINK
