SENIOR SUNSET -- Saturday, April 8, 2023

The class advisors, Kelly Foreman and Crystal Roberts, along with the senior class officers are planning a senior sunset event for all seniors on Saturday, April 8, beginning at 6:30 p.m. Each student will receive a meal from Brookside BBQ and a drink as part of the event (additional meals/food can be bought for \$10). Then, the movie *Maverick* will be shown on the large screen in the auditorium. Specific times for the evening are:

NONE FOR UNDER 21 & SENIOR GUIDANCE ASSEMBLY & RECEPTION -- Friday, April 28, 2023

All seniors will be attending their final senior class meeting first period and the *None for Under 21* rally event at Kent State University on Friday, April 28. Seniors are to report to first period class for attendance and then they will be called down to the auditorium at 7:35 am. The meeting will review the end-of-year events, graduation requirements and expectations, and any final information regarding credits, transcripts, awards, scholarships, etc. Following the assembly, we will load the busses and go to KSU for the rally. Once finished, we will return to Roosevelt for lunch.

PROM -- Saturday, April 29, 2023

The Junior-Senior prom, *A Night of Mystery*, is Saturday, April 29, from 6:00-10:00 p.m. at Todaro's Party Center in Akron. Tickets are \$40 each and will be sold April 17-21, during the lunch periods. Students who do not have a lunch period or are out of the building for CCP classes should contact Mrs. Dreher-Rodesheim or Mrs. Jurging to purchase tickets. LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM -- Thursday, May 11, 2023, 8:00 a.m. (arrive by 7:45 a.m.)

On Tuesday, May 9, 2023, the counseling office will host the Scholarship Program in the Theodore Roosevelt High School competition gym wing for the senior recipients of any local scholarships. Recipients and parents/guardians will sit with or near the scholarship representative(s) during the program. Please note that due to various stages of construction, parking may be very limited during this event.

<u>CAP & GOWN PICK UP</u> — Thursday, May 18, 2023, from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Seniors should plan to pick up their cap and gowns and/or tassel (cords will be included in your graduation bag at the graduation practice) on **Thursday, May, 18, from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the cafeteria concession stand**. If they were not paid for online, payment must be made upon pickup (\$50 -- cash accepted OR checks made payable to *Jostens*). Students should not decorate their caps.

SENIOR HONORS ASSEMBLY — Thursday, May 18, 2023, 7:50 a.m.

All seniors should plan to attend the Senior Honors Assembly on Thursday, May 18, 2023. Seniors should be seated by 7:45 a.m. in the auditorium. We will be presenting our senior awards and scholarships, and the anticipated Senior Slideshow. This awards assembly will be for SENIORS and parents/guardians only. Please note that due to various stages of construction, parking may be very limited during this event. The event will also be livestreamed on the TRHS Student Activities YouTube channel.

SENIOR CLASS PICNIC — Thursday, May 18, 2023, 11:30 a.m.

Following the Senior Honors Assembly, the seniors are invited to attend the Senior Class Picnic at Plum Creek Park, beginning at 11:30 a.m. This will be an opportunity for seniors to be outside, to eat, play outdoor field games, and enjoy one last time together as a class before graduation. GRADUATION REHEARSAL - Friday, May 19, 2023, 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. @ KSU MAC Center

All seniors should attend the mandatory graduation rehearsal (if planning on participating in the ceremony) at Kent State's MAC Center on Summit Street.

GRADUATION CEREMONY — Sunday, May 21, 1:00 p.m.

The 2023 Graduation Ceremony will be held at the Kent State University MAC Center on Summit Street. Students should arrive thirty (30) minutes prior to the start time and should line up in the halls in cap, gown, and tassel. Tassels should be on the right side of their caps.
