

ELLSWORTH SCHOOL DEPARTMENT
TECHNOLOGY PROTECTION PROGRAM

The Ellsworth School Department (ESD) Board (ESDB) offers a Technology Protection Program (TPP) that provides financial protection for parents for “non-warranty/non-misuse” technology repairs.

Parents have the option to participate in this optional TPP provided by the ESD.

This TPP covers all non-warranty damage that is not determined to be vandalism, negligence, misuse and/or intentional damage (misuse) by an Apple Certified Macintosh Technician (ACMT)¹

Under this TPP, parents are responsible for a “school year” program fee of \$35, with a \$50 deductible fee for each occurrence of non-warranty damage.

Program Fee: \$35.00 per year
 \$20 per student, per year, not to exceed \$30 per family, for reduced lunch eligible students
 \$10 per student, per year, not to exceed \$15 per family, for free lunch eligible students

Incident Fee: \$50.00 for each incident not covered by warranty.

(For example, if your son/daughter incurs damage to the computer issued to them, if you are enrolled in the TPP, payment due would be the \$50.00 incident fee, versus the actual cost of repair)

Cleaning Fee: If a technology item is returned with stickers or decals, etc., a \$10 fee will be billed.

Costs of repairs will be consistent with manufacturers’ costs.

NOTE # 1 Excludes cleaning.

NOTE # 2: As in all ESD Policies, “Parent” refers to a parent and/or legal Guardian.
