**B. Approve Budget Amendment Five:** Mr. Rhea recommended to the School Board for approval the line items listed below for the 2021-2022 school year.

**General Purpose School Fund:** Net increase in appropriations of \$1,152,410. This is funded by an increase in revenues of \$103,500 and a reduction in Fund Balance of \$1,048,910.

**Federal Projects Fund:** #892 & #893 IDEA Partnership for Systematic Change – Grant carry-forward from prior year \$362.07

**Cafeteria Fund:** Increase appropriations of \$120,439. This is funded by increased revenues of \$221,439. At this time, the resulting increase in fund balance of \$101,000 will be utilized for future increases in Central Office administrative costs and café equipment needs.

A motion was made by Joey Smith to approve Budget Amendment Five, with a second by Merle Pryse. The motion carried 5-0 (roll call vote).
