The right to leave school property for a school-sponsored activity is a privilege and may be suspended or revoked if a student violates any Board of Education policies, provisions of the Student Code of Conduct, or State or local laws, including traffic rules and regulations, while s/he is on school property or off school property. All provisions of the Student Code of Conduct and Board of Education policies shall be in effect while the student is off school property and participating in the school-sponsored activity, and the student is expected to comply with all such rules and regulations. Violations of such rules and/or regulations may result in appropriate disciplinary action.

The Student's use of motor vehicles to travel to and from a school-sponsored activity is a privilege and involves an assumption of liability on the part of the student and his/her parents, and a responsibility in the care of property, in the observation of safety rules, and in the display of courtesy and consideration toward others. The Board of Education, its officers, employees, representatives and agents shall not be responsible for motor vehicles which are lost, stolen or damaged and/or for injury, death or loss to persons or property resulting from personal operation of a motor vehicle on school property, while traveling to or from the school-sponsored activity, or while participating in the school-sponsored activity, including but not limited to riding in another privately owned vehicle.
