Objectives

Weekly Schedule

Students will continue their study of Montana Geography through examining the Montana Road Map.

Students will be able to understand how to use the 'City Index' with it's symbols to locate County Seats.

Students will be able to identify Montana Counties by locating the 'Yellow Dashed Border' surrounding the 56 counties

Students will be able to identify the -- major Montana rivers.

Students will be able to identify the aforementioned with at least 70% accuracy.

Students will conclude the week with a current event that is within the context of World Geography (ie. flora/fauna, culture, and any unique event that sparks interest and learning. This lesson will also fulfill the students weekly writing.
