

Code No. 508.4 TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM SCHOOL-SPONSORED ACTIVITIES

All students are expected to travel to and from away-from-school activities in transportation provided by the school. The activity teachers or sponsor shall establish departure times and the tentative hour of return. As a rule, students are expected to travel as a group to any event. Exceptions must be cleared with the administration or designee prior to the activity. Alternatives to travel with the group in school vehicles are as follows:

1. A student may ride home with parents/guardians upon written or verbal notification to the high school office by 2:30 P. M. on the day of the activity with approval of the Superintendent or designee. The intent of this notification is so that coach isn't bothered before, during, or after the activity and because of bookkeeping to remember who went home with whom.
2. A student is not to ride home with someone else's parents unless in the case of an extreme emergency situation, provided the coach/sponsor has been given verbal permission by the parent/guardian.

Exceptions to the policy may occur in summer sports where an athlete, because of work commitments, might need to drive to a contest. Both the parents and the coach must give prior approval. The student driver may not take other students. Violation of the rule will result in ineligibility for the contest.
