Assessment

Your counselor will talk to you about your concerns. Together, you will decide the primary issues that need to be resolved.

Counseling

If caught in the early stages, many problems can be handled right in the Bronson HelpNet office with only a few sessions. These brief counseling sessions have been prepaid by your employer as a part of the Employee Assistance Program. There is no cost to you.

A Community Referral

Some problems require more time or are outside of our scope of services. If this happens, we will guide you to an affordable community professional with a good reputation for helping other people in your situation. We'll explain your health benefits package provided by your employer and any co-pay or out-of-pocket expenses you may incur.

If a contracting employer seeks information, we provide only statistics — no name or diagnoses are ever given without written permission from the patient.
