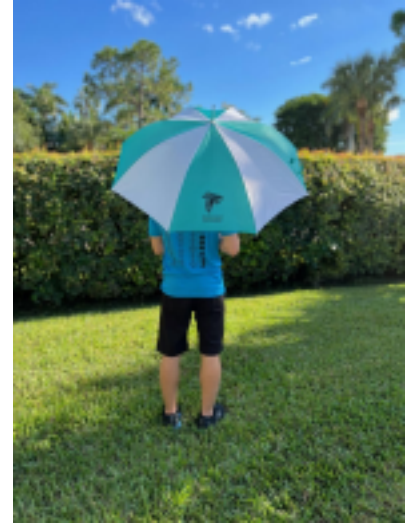

Volunteer Registration

- All volunteers, including staff and students, are required to complete the e270 Volunteer Registration Form with the Martin County School District.
- Volunteer registration is required every year. Follow the link to register as a volunteer <https://apps.raptortech.com/Apply/MTEwOTplbi1VUw==>

Volunteer Levels:

>>Student: For current MCSD students only.

****ALL adult volunteers at JBHS must be Level 2****

>> Level 2: For applicants who will work with students in an unsupervised manner (out of sight or hearing of MCSD staff), as chaperones, or after school hours. Includes: Volunteer Athletic Coaches, Volunteer Drivers and summer camp volunteers. Level 2 volunteers must be fingerprinted at the cost of \$49.00 to the volunteer. All volunteers are checked against the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's Sexual Predators and Offenders Registry prior to being placed in any volunteer position. All Level 2 Volunteers are required to pass a Level 2 criminal background screening with fingerprinting.
