  - 3. Alternate classes have a number (2,3,4...9) under the Elective Priority Column

- 1. Psychology 1 and 2 will be offered next year. Please add it to your requests if you are looking for a psychology class that is not AP.
- 2. Intensive Reading classes have been added to course requests based on 2022-23 PM3 reading scores.
- 3. Pre-calculus will only be offered at the AP level.

\*Students must have 7 course requests (including specifying periods for off-blocks if applicable). Only 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible for off-blocks.

\*Course level placements were determined based on student academic performance and student/parent/teacher/counselor input on the registration sheets. Requests for level change need to be emailed to the Guidance Counselor from a parent.

\*Students taking Dual Enrollment in the Fall must register with IRSC.

\*Course Request Change form will be accepted until Friday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>.

\*Graduation requirements, program requirements, and academic supports may impact your requested change(s).

\*Teacher requests will not be honored.
