Last year Newman Students got 8 of 13 spots on the calendar.

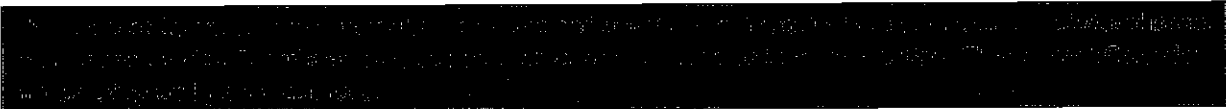
2. Recognition of Retiree: Deborah Castillo and Devon Sylvia




