

Budget Survey – Definitions for Programs

Question P1:

Extra-Curricular Activities - School sponsored activities that may be related to or fall outside of the regular academic curriculum (such as athletics, student government, and educational clubs).

After-School Activities - Organized, structured activities that are designed to encourage whole-child development (such as Digital Media, Readers Theater, Robotics, STEM, and Tutoring).

Co-curricular Activities - Are activities that take place outside of the classroom but reinforce or supplement classroom curriculum in some way (such as journalism, speech & debate, student council, and Spelling Bee).

Instructional Activities - Any activity that is related to the curriculum and learning outcomes for students (such as labs, classroom learning activities, field trips, and Challenger Learning Center – experiential learning).
