Part III – STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

I understand that during my suspension, I am **NOT** eligible to hold student office or participate in interscholastic, co-curricular, or any other extracurricular activities. Furthermore, I agree to the following conditions for remaining within the school district:

First Violation: The student and parent/guardian must sign the Violent/Criminal/Delinquent Acts Contract have a parent meeting, possible one-to-three-day suspension, and possible call III citation.

Second Violation: The student will have all first-violation consequences except with an increased suspension of possible five-to-seven days and possible class III citation.

Third/Subsequent Violations: The student will have a suspension of 10 days pending a long-term suspension hearing and possible class III citation.

❖ **Immediate Removal:** If the student is perceived as a significant threat to him/herself or others, the student may be immediately removed from the school for up to 10 days pending an investigation, sufficient evidence, and/or a long-term suspension hearing on a violation. Immediate Class III Citation will be issued.

❖ **Federal Gun-Free School Act:** Immediate contact of Law Enforcement in which a Class III Referral/Citation is completed. Student immediately removed from the school for up to 10 days pending an investigation, sufficient evidence, and/or a long-term hearing on a violation.
