### District Highlights

We understand that bus rides are long. Covering a large district makes it challenging to shorten routes. In addition, to its length we have tracked our own consistency. While we believe we do a really good job, we are always looking for ways to improve.

Starting next year, we will be implementing a "one-stop per student" policy. This means each family will designate a single address for all pick-ups and drop-offs, leading to more predictable routes.

By having a consistent stop, we feel parents will know when to expect their student each day. Students will also be confident about when the bus will arrive each morning.

Additionally, we are proud to inform you that we have recently purchased two new buses, the first in several years. This marks the beginning of a replacement plan, with at least one new bus added to our fleet every three years. Our aim is to maintain reliable and comfortable transportation for our students.
