Dr. Chatterton also presented the following Superintendent Goals.

- Smart Goal #1: By March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 the Superintendent will have analyzed the Organization Health data, facilitated the presentation of results to stakeholders, solicited feedback, and outlined next steps for the district.
- Smart Goal #2: By April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 the Superintendent will seek assistance in preparing a report outlining anticipated budgetary revenues, preliminary expense adjustments, draw up an amended budget if necessary, and formulate an outlook for the district's impact under Senate Bill 1947.
- Smart Goal #3: By January 12th, 2018 the Superintendent will have collaboratively draw upon focus groups to identify areas of improvement within the curricular offerings and/or implementation within each school.

Facilities discussion included enhancements that are being discussed (turf, Vo-tech, soccer). These will be shared with the community at open forum meetings.

It was decided to cancel the first closed session part of the August 13 meeting in order to tour the campus.
