The Greene County Community School District Board of Directors met in special session on April 1, 2022 in the District Board Room, located in the Middle School. President Steve Fisher attended remotely and called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. Directors Cindi Daubendiek, Michelle Fields, John McConnell and Bonnie Silbaugh; and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present; also attending electronically were Search Consultant Lyle Schwartz and Superintendent Candidate Brett Abbotts.

Fields made and Daubendiek seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

At 7:32 a.m. McConnell made and Silbaugh seconded a motion to go into closed session as provided in Iowa Code 21.5(1)(i) of the open meetings law to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose hiring is being considered to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation, as that individual has requested a closed session. Motion carried 5-0.

The board returned to open session at 7:40 a.m.

McConnell made and Silbaugh seconded a motion to offer a Superintendent's contract to Brett Abbotts pending final background check. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Abbotts thanked the board for the opportunity. Lyle Schwartz reminded the Board that McPherson & Jacobson will continue to work with the District to establish performance objectives for Abbotts as part of the contract with them.
