Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

In spring 2022, your student took the SAT School Day (11<sup>th</sup> grade) or the WVGSA (Grades 3-8), which measures academic progress for students and schools in West Virginia. Students in 11<sup>th</sup> grade took the evidence-based reading writing, mathematics, and essay sections of the SAT School Day. Students in 11<sup>th</sup> grade also received a score for science. Students in Grades 3-8 took the English language arts (ELA) reading, ELA writing, and mathematics sections of the test, with students in Grades 5 and 8 also taking science.

On September 23<sup>rd</sup> you will receive a printed copy of your student's individual student score report for the assessment, which contains information regarding your student's performance in the tested areas based on achievement levels set for the student's grade level by West Virginia educators. To further assist parents/guardians in understanding your student's performance, in addition to the printed report you received, the West Virginia Department of Education (WVDE) is providing an individual video score report for your student as part of a statewide program.

A link to your student's individual video score report will be sent to your student's K12 student email address on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. Please work with your student to access the link in the email. Once you click on the link, you will be taken to a site where you will need to enter your student's date of birth to access the video report.

In addition to the report, you will have access to resources related to your student's assessment. After viewing the video report, we encourage you to talk with your child's teacher to discuss your child's academic progress.
