#### 2. PRESIDENT'S REMARKS:

#### 7. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

a. HEAR NHHS AG GRANT PROPOSAL AND PLANS:

Khylee Massey (President), Allie Houston (Vice-President), and Emma Barnett (Reporter) of NHHS FFA along with VoAg teacher Jacob Lang, shared a power point with the BOE about plans to start a "Farm to School" program at NHHS. In detail they explained how the plan would be implemented and financed. They have already received gifts and grants as follows, \$7,000 from Frontier Farm Credit, \$2,500 from Monsanto Fund, \$2,500 from DuPont/Pioneer. USD 251 will help with about \$10,000 to get the project started.

b. HEAR CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION REPORT:

Mrs. Mayes shared all the professional development tasks that staff have to complete. She shared what subjects were part of the past and will be at upcoming Inservices.

c. HEAR ELEMENTARY PRINCIPAL REPORT:

Mr. Wiltz briefly spoke of past and upcoming events in his building. He gave kudos to Elly Dice for her Civic Action Training Squad (CATS) elective class.

d. HEAR HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL REPORT:

Mrs. Fort briefly spoke of past and upcoming events in her building. She thanked Mr. Mathes for allowing her to purchase furniture for the commons area at NHHS.

e. HEAR FACILITIES UPDATE:

Mr. Mathes gave an update on current facility issues. He spoke of needs and wants. Some of the high needs at NHHS are secured entrances, replacing portables, adding 6 classrooms, remodel of the office area, and repairing/replacing the track. Some of the elementary needs are a cafeteria, a new gym, the old gym would become the new cafeteria, and old cafeteria would become district office. They further need 6 specialized classrooms and secured entrances. Mr. Mathes also said that so far there has been no interest from anyone in the community for a pre-school program at Reading.

The BOE will meet next Wednesday, September 19, 2018 at 6 p.m. for a Study Session.

#### 8. ACTION ITEMS:

a. CONSIDER CAPITAL OUTLAY PURCHASE PLAN FOR 2018-19:

Mr. Mathes shared the plan with everyone present. Tammie Reed (Wendy Linsey) moved to approve the proposed 2018-19 Capital Outlay Purchase Plan. Motion passed. (7-0)

b. CONSIDER HIRING PATRON INSIGHT FOR POLLING/SURVEY:

Mr. Mathes explained what Patron Insight could do for our district. The survey results are excellent data. Angela Anderson (Wendy Linsey) moved to approve hiring Patron Insight with a cost up to \$16,300. Motion passed. (7-0)

#### 9. PERSONNEL:

a. CONSIDER RESIGNATIONS:

Angela Anderson (Wendy Linsey) moved to accept the resignation from Rick Bush, Business Teacher at NHHS, for the end of the 2017-18 school year. Motion passed. (7-0)

b. Angela Anderson (Tim Burton) moved to go into executive session, inviting Mr. Mathes, to discuss non-elected personnel exception under KOMA, and the open meeting will resume in the board room at 8:17 p.m. Motion passed. (7-0)

The Board and Mr. Mathes left the room at 8:12 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 8:17 p.m.

#### 10. BOARD COMMENTS:

Wendy Linsey likes the newsletter being mailed again and has received positive feedback from the community for it as well. She thanked Mrs. Mayes, Mrs. Fort, and Mr. Wiltz for all their hard work. She enjoyed the great presentation by FFA students, she is excited to see the program grow and thanked Mr. Lang as well. Tim Burton dittoed Wendy on the FFA presentation and program. He said that his Kids are stoked about the new program.

Angela Anderson gave kudos to the Mini Families program integrated this year at USD 251. She feels it's an awesome program and it will create many friendships. She further believes the Farm to Table program is amazing. David Goldsmith Jr. thanked everybody. He said everyone is doing an excellent job.

Tammie Reed said that the district is headed in the right direction. She's happy to see that the communities are involved in the schools.

Matt Horton dittoed Tammie on the community involvement. He invited everyone to come out to this Friday's Tailgate Party and the Football game afterwards. Homecoming is the next big event, he said "Let's make this one great". He thanked everyone for the great job they do for USD 251. He also encouraged Mr. Lang to talk to adjoining landowners about the "Farm to School" program.
