We want to inform you of an incident reported this morning and of the steps taken to ensure the ongoing safety of our students and staff. We want to make sure you have accurate information and dispel any rumors you may have heard.

Early this morning, school administration received information of a potential safety threat made on social media directed at a fellow staff member. Law enforcement was immediately contacted and were able to quickly locate the individual at an off-campus location.

Law enforcement did not place the school campus in a Lockdown or a Secure, as it was determined that there was no immediate threat.

We appreciate students, staff, and parents reporting unusual or potentially unsafe situations and I am proud of the work our students and staff are doing and have done in regards to openly communicating with us when there are concerns.

We will continue with our scheduled expanded lockdown drill this week with our community partners. Incidents such as these are a reminder of the importance of these drills and why we diligently practice them each year.

When we conduct safety drills, we invite our local first responders to participate, giving them first-hand knowledge of the school's layout and what to expect from staff and students in the event of an emergency. They also provide us with feedback to enhance our ability to keep students safe in the event of an emergency.
