SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND SCHOOL CHOICE

In response to Arkansas' approved **Elementary and Secondary Education Act** (ESEA) Flexibility Request, the U.S. Department of
Education has granted Arkansas schools a waiver of § 1116(b)(5) of the
No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. This section formerly required schools
in year 2 or greater of school improvement to provide supplemental
educational services from providers approved by the **Arkansas Department of Education** (ADE). Because of this waiver, Arkansas
schools are no longer required to provide **Supplemental Educational Services** (SES) through approved SES providers. Arkansas schools
are no longer required to set aside 20% of Title I funds for school choice
and SES

Therefore, for the duration of this waiver, the ADE will not consider or approve applications from SES providers for approval. The Department will no longer maintain a list of approved SES providers.
