
BusQuest App - Parent Guide

Your school district has opted to use the BusQuest App and Travel Tracker Routing Parent Portal – What does that mean for you? You will now have access to information about your child's transportation at your fingertips. With the BusQuest App, you will be able to see where your student's bus is and plan accordingly!

The following document outlines the steps you need to take to successfully set up and login to these features.


Step One:

Download The BusQuest App from the App store on your mobile device



Step Two:

Open app and select Create Parent Account




Step Three:

Type in Aztec and select Aztec Municipal Schools, NM




Step Four:

Select either phone or email to setup your account. Note: Use email or phone number that you have in your students PowerSchool account




Step Five:

Select Relationship to the student, fill out first and last name, create a password and select register




Step Six:

You will receive an email with a link. Select the link and login from your phone.



After you have successfully downloaded the app, open it and log in using the same email and password you created for logging in to the Parent Portal.




This is what the first page of the BusQuest app looks like. It will have all your student information. Again, if you have more than 1 student, it will show them all.




At the bottom of this screen tap where it says "Bus Tracker." This is the function that will allow you to set how close you want the bus to be when it notifies you of its location.



On this page, you set the distance at which you will be notified of the bus approaching.



You can do this by selecting "draw" and drawing a polygon around your residence to your preferred distance/size.



Alternatively, you can select "circle" and set the distance of the circle in miles.

Click apply and you are all set to be notified when your student's bus is near!
