

Bus Rider Rules and Regulations

Our number one goal in having this bus rider contract is to ensure the safety of all children to and from school. In order to accomplish this goal, we need the cooperation of the student bus riders. Student behavior while boarding, riding, and leaving the bus contributes in many ways to the driver's ability to provide safe transportation.

Please review the following information with your child concerning student conduct on the bus.

Conduct on the Bus:

1. Follow the directions of the bus driver. Many bus drivers provide assigned seats.
2. Remain seated (possibly in assigned seat) for the duration of the ride.
3. Talk quietly so that the driver can hear traffic sounds and focus on driving.
4. Keep your hands and property inside the bus.
5. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
6. Use appropriate language.
7. Keep any food or drinks in your backpack.
8. Phones may be used but are your responsibility. Use them appropriately.
9. Remain seated until the bus comes to a full stop.
10. Make sure your area is clean before exiting.

Possible Follow Up Procedures

1. Driver warns student.
2. Conference with driver on bus after other students exit.
3. Student may be assigned a seat by the bus driver or administrator.
4. Driver writes up an official School Bus Conduct Notice about the incident.
5. Student conferences with school administrator and parents may be notified
6. Repeated or serious misconduct on the bus may result in a parent meeting, the student being suspended from the bus, school detention or suspension, or losing bus privileges for an undetermined length of time.
7. If there are damages to the bus or property on a bus, a student and their parents will be held responsible for the cost to replace or repair the item(s).

Parent/Guardians of all students (even if they are not an every-day bus rider) are asked to sign with and sign the statement below.

I am aware of and agree with the standards of conduct expected by School Lane Charter School for bus riders and I understand and agree with the expectations which are necessary in order to provide for the safety and welfare of all children.
