7.2 Approve 2nd Grade teacher hire

Stacy Conrow-Ververis motioned to open agenda item 7.2, Jaime Talbot seconded the motion; Julia Willhite was interview by Mr. Labbe, Ms. Nagy, Mrs. Kari Labbe, Mrs. Hanson and Mr. Kinney. It is recommended by Mr. Kinney and the hiring committee to hire Ms. Willhite as 2nd Grade teacher for the 2022-23 school year, all in favor, **motion carries 5-0**.

7.3. Approve JH-HS mathematics hire

Dan Hazlett motioned to open agenda item 7.3, Shane Quick seconded the motion; Natalie Faupel was interviewed by Mr. Labbe, Ms. Nagy, Mrs. Ms. Randall, Mrs. Milender and Mr. Kinney. It is recommended by Mr. Kinney and the hiring committee to hire Ms. Faupel as junior high/high school mathematics for the 2022-23 school year, Dan Hazlett asked if any other applicant in which Mr. Kinney responded that we did have one other very qualified applicant. All in favor, **motion carries 5-0.**

7.4 Approve summer health enhancement program

Stacy Conrow-Ververis motioned to open agenda item 7.4, Shane Quick seconded the motion. Mr. Schultz would like to propose a summer health enhancement program by opening the weight room for jr. high and high school students Monday thru Thursday with two sessions per day running 7 to 8am and 8-9am.
