### BLAINE HIGH SCHOOL EXTRA-CURRICULAR RULES

7/15

Extra-Curricular Participants Include (but are not limited to): Athletes, Cheerleaders, Managers, Statisticians, Video Crew, Athletic trainers, Math Team, Knowledge Bowl, Teen Court, Chess Team, Drama, etc.

Philosophy: Participation in extra-curricular activities is voluntary and selection of candidates is necessary. This selection is based on performance, attitude, conduct, cooperation, and an earnest and sincere desire to represent the program, school and community. Playing time for any participant is not guaranteed and is determined by the coach of each extra-curricular program.

The following are disciplinary actions that will be implemented for the described rule violation. All violations are cumulative during a student's four years of high school. This will include: Possession or use of tobacco products, alcohol, legend drugs, and controlled substances, present or in proximity where there are drugs and alcohol.

1. A) **Alcohol:** If a participant is found using, consuming, appears to be under the influence of/or in possession or in the presence or proximity of alcohol he/she will be subject to the following disciplinary action.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Violation - Removal from 30% of the extra-curricular program contests. Unused removal % in current season will carry over into the next season. (Reduced to 20% if violation is voluntarily reported before any investigation has been started by the school district or law enforcement, 25% if cooperative during investigation.)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Violation - Removal from extra-curricular program. Mandatory evaluation/treatment will be required before continuance of any extra-curricular participation, at parent's expense and a 2-month time period has elapsed from beginning date of suspension. (Reduced to 50% if violation is voluntarily reported before any investigation has been started by the school district or law enforcement)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Violation - Permanently prohibited from participation in any Blaine High School extra-curricular program.

B) Participants found in violation of Section 1A during the "off season" (this includes summer and between programs) will incur the following disciplinary actions:

1<sup>st</sup> Violation - Removal from 10% of the next season's program contests.

Other violations will continue with disciplinary action violation #1.

C) **Tobacco:** If a participant is found using, consuming tobacco or smokeless tobacco (E-Cigarettes) will be subject to the following disciplinary action:

1<sup>st</sup> Violation - The student will be counseled on the hazards of tobacco to his/her health and will be restricted from 10% of the extra-curricular program contests.

2<sup>nd</sup> Violation - The student will be counseled on the hazards of tobacco to his/her health and will be restricted from 20% of the extra-curricular program contests.

3<sup>rd</sup> Violation - The student will be excluded from the remainder of the extra-curricular program.

4<sup>th</sup> Violation - Permanently prohibited from participation for one (1) calendar year from the date of the violation.

D) **Legend drugs and controlled substances:** Penalties for the possession, use or sale of legend drugs (drugs obtained through prescription, RCW 69.41.020-050) and controlled substance (RCW 69.50) shall be as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Violation: A participant shall be immediately ineligible for interscholastic competition in the current interscholastic sports program for the remainder of the season. Ineligibility shall continue until the next sports season in which the participant wishes to participate unless the student accesses the assistance program outline below:

\*If the athlete seeks and receives help for a problem with use of legend drugs or controlled substances the athlete may be reinstated in that athletic season.

2<sup>nd</sup> Violation - Removal from extra-curricular programs for one calendar year.

3<sup>rd</sup> Violation - Permanently prohibited from participation in any WIAA extra-curricular program.

2. Unacceptable student behavior not covered above, including, but not limited to, violations requiring administrative action as established in the "Student Conduct Expectations and Reasonable Sanctions" (Policy 3240), will be dealt with as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Violation - Minimum removal from 30% of the extra-curricular program contests. Unused removal % in current season will carry over into the next season.

2<sup>nd</sup> Violation - Minimum removal from the program.

3<sup>rd</sup> Violation - Exclusion for full calendar year from date of the violation.

3. A participant must be present in all classes to be eligible for a contest or turnout that day. Exceptions to this are if the participant has prearranged excuse through the office for reasons other than illness.

4. If a participant is truant from any class/classes, he/she will receive at minimum a suspension from the next scheduled contest in which the student is a participant. Refer to Policy 2150 if multiple trancies occur.

5. Scholastic eligibility is based on the previous semester. Fall and Winter sports - June; Spring sports - January.

A) A participant is eligible by meeting the following:

1. Pass 5 out of 6 classes with a minimum 1.5 GPA

B) Any participant who does not meet Blaine High School standards will be placed on a 5-week probation.

1. A participant on probation must be passing Blaine High School standards at the 5-week grade check or will be removed from the activity.

2. Spring sport athletes will be given an additional three weeks to improve grades or will be removed from the activity.

C) Grade checks will occur for all athletes every three weeks during the season from the beginning of the season.

1. Any athlete receiving one or more failing grade(s) or is below a 1.5 GPA will be checked on a weekly basis to determine eligibility.

6. Any participant suspended from school will receive a minimum suspension from 10% of the program contests.

7. Any participant will comply with all other WIAA rules and regulations found in the WIAA handbook.

8. Any student, parent or guardian who is aggrieved by the suspension or termination of extra-curricular privileges under these rules shall have the right to an informal conference with the building principal or his/her designee for the purpose of resolving the grievance. During such conference, the student, parent or guardian shall be subject to questioning by the building principal or his/her designee and shall be entitled to question school personnel involved in the matter being grieved.

The student and his/her parent or guardian whose signatures appear below do hereby acknowledge they have received a copy of these extra-curricular rules and, having read the same, understand the conditions regarding participation by the student in Blaine High School Extra-Curricular activities covered by these rules.
