Two students recognized by National Merrit Scholarship, more information will be coming soon. Both Choirs heading to state for Choral competition and Ms. Pitts thinks they me able to come in best in state. Peter Pan went well with special performances and hope to plan more in the future.
- Celebrate the Arts went very well. It was an entertainment and dinner evening. Students
  performed, there was dancing after, Ms. Wenzel's students did on the spot poetry for people after a
  quick interview for \$5 and Rockhoppers closed out the night. Several of our vendors purchased
  tickets to support PTG.
- Lottery results It went very well. 736 Lottery applicants were in and 360 were chosen. HS 7th grade 100, 8th grade 95, 9th grade 69, 10 grade 89, 11th grade 64, 12th grade 64. Total is at 1041 at this point for K-12. Goal is 1225 but can't reach that goal until school is completed. These numbers are confirmed. The 9th grade was lower because many were also chosen at HAAS Hall and they did their lottery in February. Might want to revisit the time on Lottery next year.
