Scholarship Application

Amount: Up to \$2,500

The following guidelines apply to the scholarship:

- The George Grant Chapter of Trout Unlimited (GGTU) is making up to \$2,500 available for scholarships in 2023. A single student may receive a \$2,500 scholarship or two students may be awarded scholarships of \$1,250 each.
- Only graduating seniors are eligible to apply.
- Must have at least one recommendation from one of their senior class teachers.
- Students that have volunteered for environmental conservation projects, programs or groups will receive higher placement.
- Students must complete the application on time to be eligible for the scholarship.

o Deadline is February 21, 2023

- The Recipient must apply for the scholarship to further their education at a technical school, beauty academy, 2-year or 4-year college, etc...
- Any applicant with a tuition waiver to their educational school of choice will still be considered. All scholarships and fee waivers received must be listed on the application.
- This Scholarship will be paid directly to the student in 2 installments:
 - o 50% of scholarship amount for Fall Semester 2023 upon proof of enrollment.
 - 50% of scholarship amount for Spring Semester 2024 upon proof of enrollment AND proof of a GPA of 2.5 or C+ equivalent.
- The winning applicant will be recognized at the Annual GGTU Banquet held in March 2023 in Butte, Montana. GGTU will pay for <u>your ticket plus a guest</u> but welcome any friends and family to purchase additional tickets.

All information will be verified prior to evaluating and awarding scholarship.
