

Collect the following documents to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid):

- Social Security Number
- Records of income- This includes income earned from work, child support paid or received, or any other untaxed income.
- W-2 forms and tax return forms for the previous year
- Information about assets such as savings, certificates of deposit, stocks, college saving plans, investment real estate, business and farm
- Driver's license number
- Dates of birth for student and parent
- Month and year of marriage, separation, or divorce

Student and Parent information is required. After you have gathered all of the required documents, we can set up a FSA ID so you can log in at fafsa.gov and complete the FAFSA.
