enable the district to maintain 2 months of operating expenditures. \$458,991.	
A reserave for Post employment benefits for retirees is being held for a total of \$30,000.	
Reserves are held for Roof Repairs of \$100,000, HVAC's \$60,000 and facility repairs &
