Bugler's Dream Leo Arnaud, arr Paul Lavender

This was the first piece that we learned together in which each instrument grouping had their own separate part. The kids were so excited when they were finally able to play it together. Leo Arnaud was a French composer who moved to the United States and worked in Hollywood. He originally composed Bugler's Dream in 1958, but it achieved prominence starting in 1964 when it was used as theme music for the Olympic telecast on ABC. Paul Lavender has carefully arranged it for our beginning musicians.

Latin Magic John Higgins

This piece includes snippets of "La Bamba" which was originally a Mexican folk song before it was made famous by Richie Valens in 1958. This song has a lot of energy and is fun to play.

Selections from Songs for Mastery Various

As we worked on learning to play our instruments, we learned many different folk songs from a collection titled Songs for Mastery. They were sequenced in difficulty, with each song introducing a new note or concept. We'd like to share a few of them with you tonight.

Centurion Mark Williams

Centurions were leaders in the Roman military, which at the height of its power ruled over much of the Western world. This music attempts to portray these imposing warriors. This was the most challenging piece we learned, because it was longer and more complex than any of the other music that we learned.

These Elementary Band students started their musical journey last September. While beginning band is always difficult, the restrictions we had to work with due to COVID added another layer of complexity and required the students to work harder just to learn the basics. But your students were quite persistent! First, they learned how to put their instrument together and then just make a sound. Despite the challenges, they progressed to playing simple songs in unison and then to playing in harmony as a band. It is such a pleasure to look back and see how much they have grown over the course of the school year. This is just the beginning of their musical adventures, so we encourage them to continue studying music as they enter middle school.
