

## MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2021

The Piggott School District Board of Education met in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, September 8, 2021 in the District Administrative Office. Members present were Hope Burns, Brad Dunlap, Chris Roberts and Jim Threatt.

Board President, Hope Burns called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

Board President, Hope Burns, waived the reading of The Regular Board Meeting held Tuesday, August 10, 2021 and the Special Board Meeting held Wednesday, August 25, 2021.

The Board discussed Banning a community member from school campus and events. Mr. Bowen said the incident in question has been investigated by our SRO and the Sheriff's Department.

The Board said the school needs to make sure that the old gym is secure at all times and keys are not to be given out to anybody except the coaches.


Add discussion of honoring Hunter Midkiff.
