

Use of Homer Hanson Stadium, Track, Walking Track, and Other District Facilities, Property, and Supplies

Homer Hanson Stadium, the track, and the walking track are available for use by USD 364 patrons at designated times or at times when students are not present for exercise to improve the general health and wellness of community members. However, these facilities are not to be used for personal or corporate profit without the express written permission from the USD 364 Superintendent. If a group or individuals are using school district facilities and making a profit or charging a fee without prior approval from the superintendent, they will be asked to immediately cease such activity. Groups or individuals who are using district facilities without prior approval risk having their rights to use district facilities restricted or completely denied in the future. Groups or individuals who wish to make a profit or charge a fee for their services must be preapproved or they should use private property or other public property instead of using school district facilities.

This same expectation applies for all other district facilities along with property and supplies purchased for use by or with our students and/or student athletes.

Children under the age of 18 must have adult supervision when they are using any district facilities.

Video cameras are in place throughout the building and around our school buildings and our system is recording the activities of people in and around our buildings.

The primary use of district facilities is for the students and as such the district reserves the right to close any or all district facilities for special events as needed.

This policy and the hours of operation for the walking track and for other district facilities are subject to change at any time based on misuse or abuse of the facilities, lack of appropriate supervision of children, or other problems that may arise.

Walking Track Hours of Operation

The walking track located inside the Activity Center at Marysville Junior/Senior High will be open to the public at the following times:

Mornings

Monday through Friday 6:00 to 7:30

Evenings

Monday through Friday 5:30 to 9:00 when there are no activities scheduled

If there are activities scheduled the public can still come use the walking track, but they will be expected to pay the cost of admittance for that event.

Additional information related to the walking track –

- Patrons will access the walking track through the doors at the top of the stairs on the North side of the building
- Children under the age of 18 must have adult supervision at all times
- Video cameras are in place throughout the building and recording the activities of people in and around the walking track area
- The district reserves the right to close the walking track for special events as needed
- The hours of operation for the walking track and access to the walking track in general are subject to change at any time based on misuse or abuse of the facilities, lack of appropriate supervision of children, or other problems that may arise
- Access to the school building will be limited, but there will be access to restrooms
- Patrons are encouraged to sign in on the clipboard in the hallway between the two gyms so that we have a record of how many people are using the walking track
