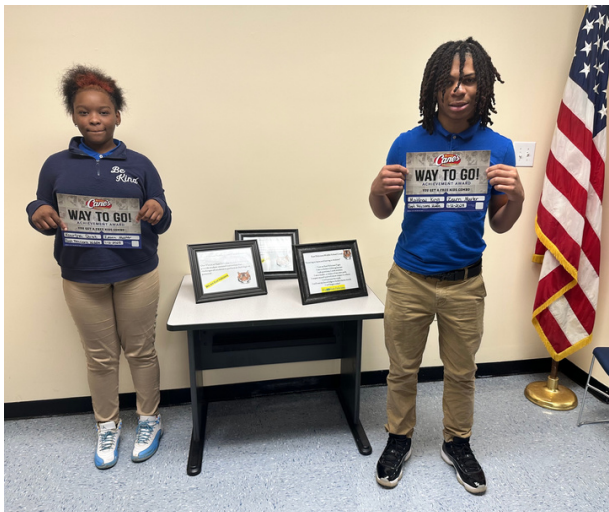
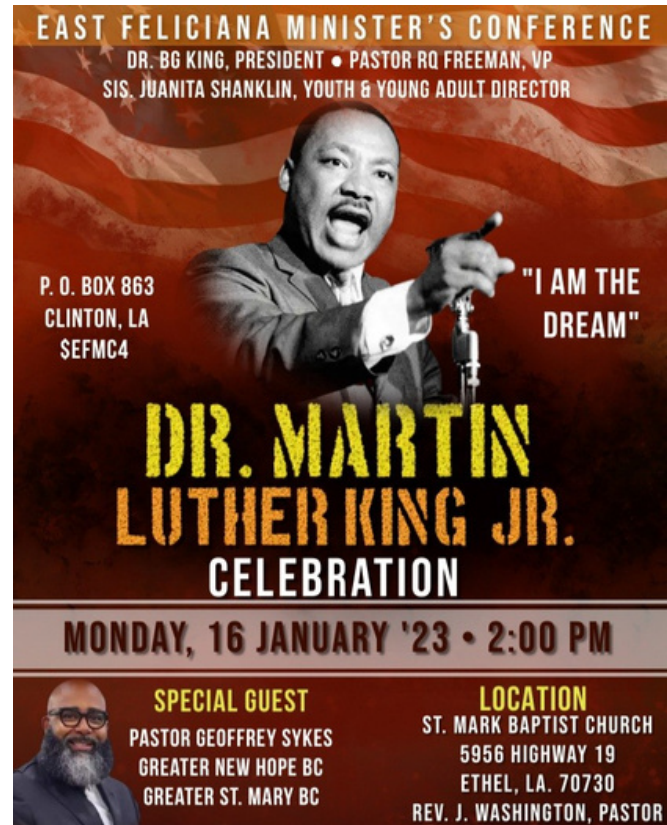

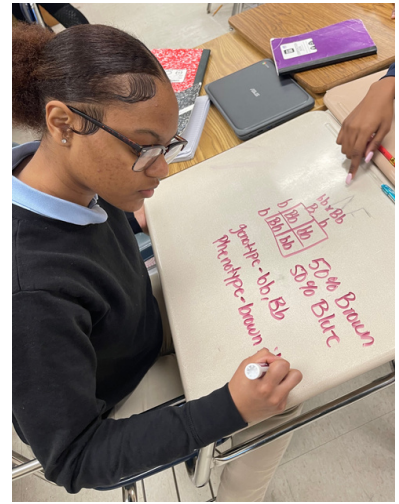
On the Grow at EF STEAM

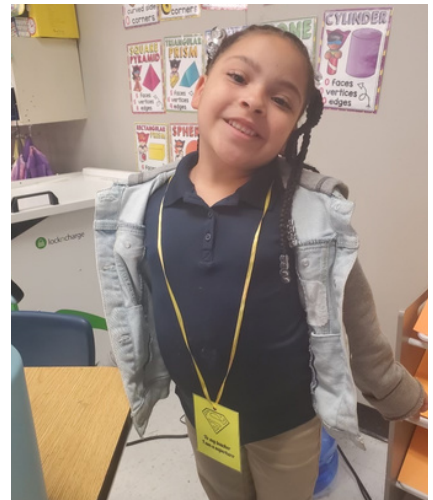
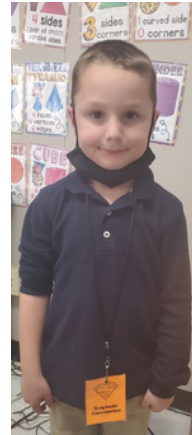
The Probability of Engaging Learning at EFHS is High!
