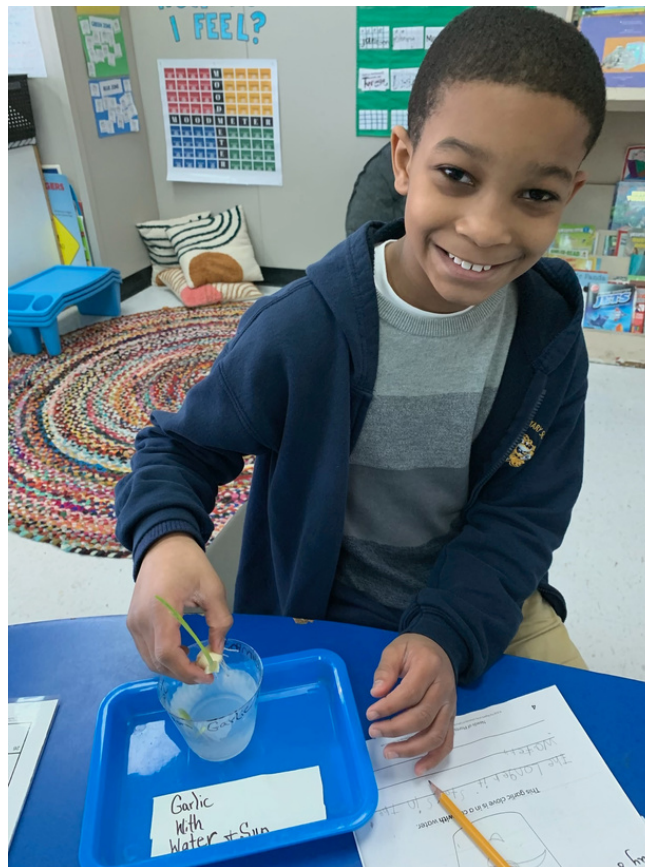
## *Laissez les bons temps rouler at CES*

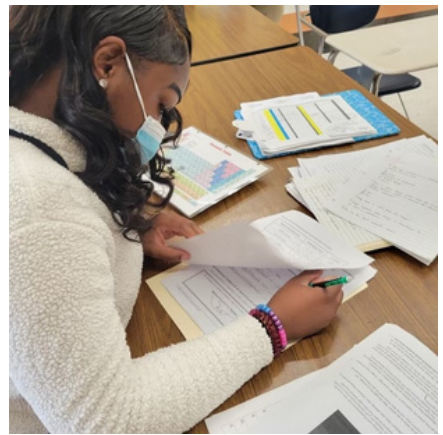

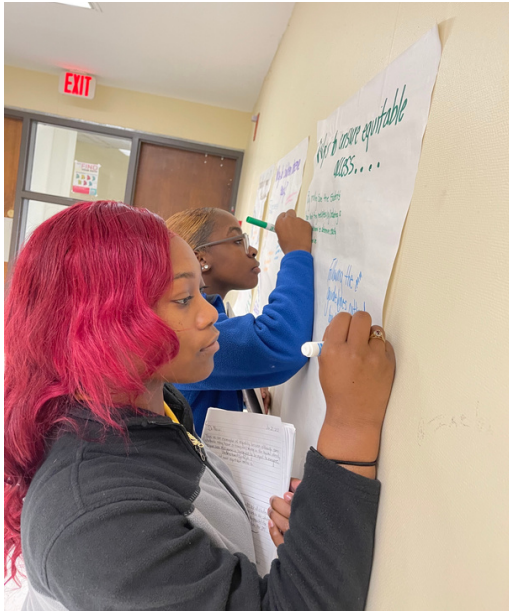
# All It Takes is a Little Chemistry

## Inspiring the Future at East Feliciana High School

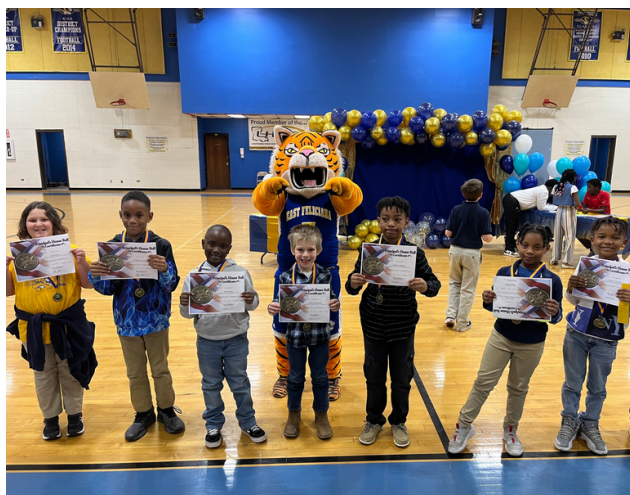
