

Members of the East Feliciana High School Student Government Association observed Random Acts of Kindness Day on Friday, February 17 by passing out treats to their classmates and teachers.


EFMS Jr. Beta Club Explores Black History

Pictured above, first grade students at Jackson Elementary School had their first day of their bowling unit in their health and physical education class this week.


Championship Spotlight
