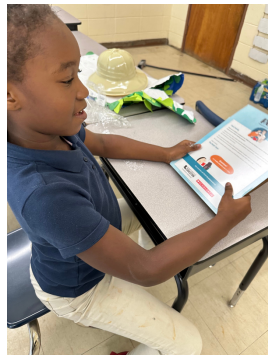

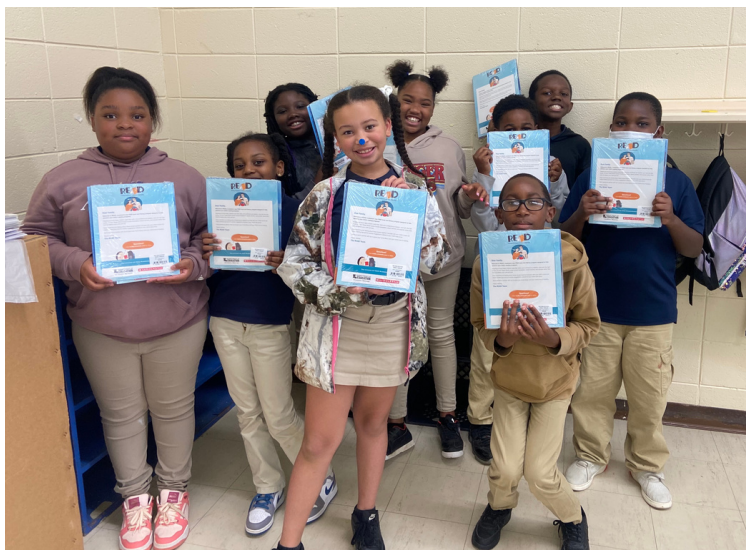
On the Way to First Grade at JES!

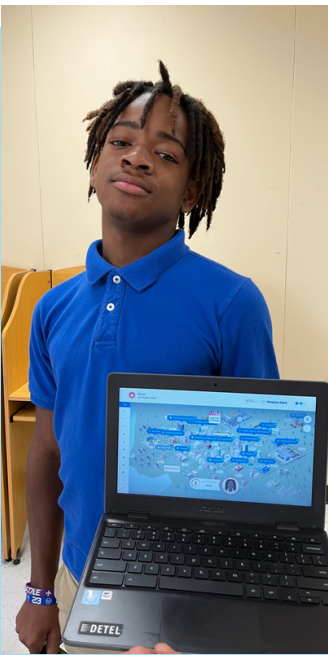
CES READS!
