Title:

The legal basis for public education in the district is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Wisconsin Constitution. Public education is primarily a state responsibility and a local school district's function.

The official name of this school district is St. Croix Central School District. It is classified as a common school district and includes the municipalities of the Township of Erin Prairie, Township of Hammond, Village of Hammond, Township of Kinnickinnic, Township of Pleasant Valley, Township of Richmond, Village of Roberts, Township of Rush River, and Township of Warren.

Educational services of the district shall be organized as a program of instruction for grades Pre-Kindergarten through 12. The district shall be operated as a single system by the Board of Education under the direction of the District Administrator.
