Policy Number: 341.5
Title: Physical Education

A developmental, sequential and comprehensive physical education program shall be established in the District. Such a program shall be designed to serve all 4K-12 students. Physical education instruction shall be taught by, or under the supervision of, certified staff.

The basic goals of the program center around personal physical fitness, knowledge of basic individual and team activities, lifelong activities, the opportunity for students to develop skills of responsibility and teamwork, and the overall development of a healthy body. Many of the activities are coed in structure, with the group sometimes divided according to activities or skill development.

The physical education program is designed to offer activities to all students. However, if a doctor advises against taking part in certain activities, it is necessary that a written notice from the doctor be presented. Students shall not be excused from participation for any extended period of time without a medical excuse. Provisions are made for adapted activities according to a student's IEP.

The St. Croix Central School District shall not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, religion, age, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
