Policy Number: 342.2 Title: Homebound Instruction

Homebound instruction is considered an alternative service to be provided only during specific periods of time when a student is physically and/or emotionally incapable of attending school. It is intended to: (1) assist the student in maintaining academic functioning at as normal a level as possible during the time the student is unable to attend school and (2) promote communication between the student and the school so that the student feels a part of the school community. Homebound instruction shall be provided within the limits prescribed by state law and District guidelines.

A homebound instruction plan shall be developed for the student that is based on the student's individual needs and is appropriate to the student's educational program.
