The responsibility for scheduling students to classes rests with school administration. The School Board promotes the involvement of parents/guardians, teachers, and counselors in assisting students to make appropriate course selections. Students shall be assigned to teachers and classes according to the judgment of the building principal and recommendations of other school personnel.

Students may be assigned to various types of groups within or between classes and/or classrooms in accordance with established District rules. At the secondary level, students may also self-group through the career focus process.
