These modifications, amendments, and supplements may occur at any regular or special meeting of the Ohio Schools Council Assembly at which a quorum is present. Approval of a modification, amendment or supplement requires a simple majority vote of the quorum.”

**Current Policy 1.1 and Policy 1.3**

Policy 1.1 Agreement Section 10: “This Agreement may be modified, amended, or supplemented in any respect not prohibited by law upon approval of the modification, amendment, or supplement by the governing bodies of two thirds of the Members, the amendment, modification, or supplement shall thereupon become binding upon all Members.” Policy 1.3 Bylaws Section 11: “These ByLaws May be modified, amended or supplemented in any respect upon the approval of the modification, amendment, or supplement by first at least two-thirds of the Members’ representatives and thereafter by at least two-thirds of the Members and the approved amendment, modification, or supplement shall only thereupon become binding upon all Members.”

**Rewrite of Policy 1.1 and Policy 1.3**

Policy 1.1 Agreement Section 10: “This Agreement may be modified, amended, or supplemented in any respect not prohibited by law upon approval of the modification, amendment, or supplement at an Assembly Meeting by a majority vote of the quorum of superintendents of the Members, and the amendment, modification, or supplement shall thereupon become binding upon all Members.”  
Policy 1.3 Bylaws Section 11: “These ByLaws may be modified, amended or supplemented in any respect upon the approval of the modification, amendment, or supplement at an Assembly Meeting by a majority vote of the quorum of superintendents of the Members and the approved amendment, modification, or supplement shall only thereupon become binding upon all Members.”

## EXHIBIT B

### RESOLUTION TO RESTATE THE OHIO ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BUSINESS OFFICIALS 457 DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN

The Grand Valley Local School District Board of Education, met in regular session on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 13, 2023 in the Grand Valley High School Study Hall.

**WHEREAS**, Grand Valley Local School District has previously adopted the Ohio Association of School Business Officials (“OASBO”) 457 Deferred Compensation Plan (the “plan”), a retirement plan (the “plan”) under Section 457(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”);

**WHEREAS**, OASBO last provided its member school districts with an amended and restated Plan, effective as of April 1, 2017, for adoption as the Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement Act and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act of 2020 would, in relevant part, require the Grand Valley Local School District to amend the Plan to ensure compliance with Section 457(b) of the Code and the regulations thereunder; and

**WHEREAS**, Grand Valley Local School District desires to amend and restate the Plan to incorporate the following changes:

1. Section 1.5 – Added a definition of ‘CARES Act’.
2. Section 1.12 – Added a definition of “Eligible Designated Beneficiary”.
3. Section 3.5 – Amended to permit repayments to the Plan of “CARES Act” distributions received by a Participant in 2020.
4. Section 4.1 – Amended to permit an active employee to make withdrawals at age 59 ½.
5. Section 4.1 – Also amended to permit an employee under age 59 ½ to make a CARES Act withdrawal in 2020 of up to \$100,000.
6. Section 4.3 – Amended to address the SECURE Act’s change that has the minimum distribution rules apply at age 72, instead of age 70 ½. This includes authority for VOYA and Equitable to independently address transitional rule matters under their Provider Contracts with their own customers.
7. Section 4.4 – Amended to address the SECURE Act’s modification of the minimum distribution rules that apply after the death of a Participant.
8. Exhibit A – Loan provisions – Loan provisions are modified to permit a Participant to take a loan of up to \$100,000 on or before September 23, 2020, as was allowed by the CARES Act.

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** Effective February 13, 2023, the Board of Grand Valley Local School District (the “Board”) authorizes Grand Valley Local School District to adopt the Plan as amended and restated for such federal legislation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:** The Board authorizes the school business official of Grand Valley Local School District to execute the Plan.
