


Officer Brockway

Hi, This is an interview on Mrs. Clason. She has been working at Grand Valley for 19 years. She likes to work with the kids.








Ms. Monica Hatfield is one of our Grand Valley kitchen workers. She has worked at Grand Valley for 2 years. She likes to see all of the little kids.

Ms. Hatfield has a son and a daughter. She says she likes to stay happy and have a good day everyday.






Mrs. Hejduk has been working at Grand Valley for 19 years. Math was her favorite subject in school. She likes to see different kids everyday and play games with them.








Ms. Jazbek has worked at Grand Valley for 3 years. She likes seeing the kids while she's working in the kitchen.


Do you know who Mr. Jerome is? He teaches Spanish class at the High School and here at G.V.E.S.. Here is some information about him.

This is what we found out about Mr. Jerome.




We asked when she does retire what she will do with her time. She said, "whatever I want to do". She loves hanging out with her family. When she does retire she wants to visit the beaches and mountains.



Mrs. Neuman has been working at Grand Valley for 11 years and she loves it because she loves working with the kids who make her laugh all the time! It makes her feel happy.



She has two kids and two cats. She is kind and loves teaching. She is amazing!












Mrs. Thayer has worked at Grand Valley for 23 years as a bus driver and cook. She likes working here because she likes seeing the kids.


Mr. U has been working at Grand Valley for 1 year. His favorite thing about his iob is doina Computers and Music with the Band. He likes working here because there are good people here.

favorite sports are football and hockey.







