Maroon & White Scholarship Program

Dilley ISD

The DISD Maroon and White Scholarship Program has been established to provide graduating seniors with a scholarship opportunity that can be used to further their education at colleges/universities or vocational schools. This program is made possible by the generous contributions of DISD employees who continually support the students of this community.

Contributions: Any DISD employee may make a contribution to the Maroon and White Scholarship Program. Contributions can be made by check or money order, or they can be made through bi-monthly or one-time payroll deductions. To make a contribution through payroll deduction, please see Leticia Flores at Central Office, or Debra Solis at the High School to complete a form. Checks should be payable to Maroon & White Scholarship Program and may be turned in at the Central Office. This program is a strictly voluntary in nature and follows DISD Policy DG (Legal).

Scholarship Amount: The number of scholarships given and the amount of each will be determined by the scholarship committee based on available funds.

Scholarship Committee: The scholarship committee is comprised of members of the Dilley High School faculty and staff who serve on this committee in order to select recipients for this scholarship, as well as other scholarships available to DHS students.

Criteria:

- Student must be a graduating senior or early graduate who will meet all requirements for graduation by the May or June graduation date of the current award year.
- Student must be attending a college/university or vocational school within the calendar year immediately following his/her high school graduation date.
- Student must fill out the required application and turn it in to the counselor's office by the deadline given on the application.
- Student must have been a student in DISD for at least 2 school years.
- Student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Personal qualifications: good moral character, commitment to completing a college education or vocational certification.

Notification of Recipients: The scholarship committee will decide on the recipients of the scholarship. The recipients and scholarship amounts will be announced at the scholarship presentation and awards banquet held in the spring.

Scholarship Disbursement: In order for the student to receive the scholarship they must provide the DISD Administrative Office with proof of enrollment in a college/university or vocational school. Upon receipt of this information, the scholarship amount will be sent to the college/university or vocational school in the student's name to be credited to his/her account. Checks will not be made payable to the individual student or their parent/guardian. The scholarship will only be available within one calendar year of the student's graduation date.

Applications can be picked up at the high school counselor's office during the spring semester.
