Minor Infractions (Level 1 or 2)

Minor offenses are misbehaviors managed "on the spot" (classroom, common areas, recess, etc.). Interventions used to address and correct minor offenses are documented and logged in Powerschool as FOR INFORMATION ONLY for administration. At 4 occurrences a minor becomes

Major Infractions (Level 3 or 4)

Major infractions are violations of the Educational Code which requires immediate attention of the administrative staff. The interventions used to address and correct major infractions are documented and logged in Powerschool as LEVEL 3 or 4 INFRACTION for administration.

15-Second Intervention:

At Gobles Elementary School we are Leaders, have Integrity, are Respectful, Responsible, and show Pride When you (state the behavior), "push Ann down the hallway and yell at her to go," you are not being (state the core value) "respectful" or "doing your best." I wouldn't let someone do that to you, and it's not okay that you did that to (name) Ann. We don't do that here. That needs to stop.

Core Value Reflection/Time to Think Form:

When using the interventions of time-out, time-owed, loss of privilege, buddy teachers, the restorative practice of a "Time to Think" Form should be used to give the student the opportunity to see his/her role in the misbehavior.
